

Declaration on Directive 94/62/EC on Packaging and Packaging Waste

The spools delivered by us do not fall under the definition of "packaging" as defined in the Waste-Directive 94/62/EC.

The concept of packaging within the meaning of this Directive is defined in Article 3 under points 1(a), (b) and (c).

According to these points the spools are our products and not packaging.

The Directive 94/62/EC on packaging and packaging waste was amended in February 2013. Whilst the definition of packaging is informative, the latest amendment provides detailed illustrative examples of elements that can be defined as packaging, part of packaging and non-packaging.

According to these examples, empty spools which we deliver to our customers are not packaging within the meaning of the directive 94/62/EC.

The products supplied by us comply with the current legal requirements in the Federal Republic of Germany with regard to their contents.

According to current knowledge, the materials used by us do not contain the substances mercury, cadmium, lead and hexavalent chromium.
